English - The students will be stories about the adventures of Dewey, our class guinea pig.

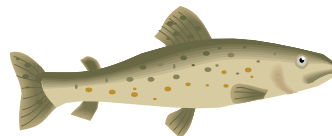
Social Studies- . The transcontinental railroad is the next topic in Social Studies.
